#### **Rules of the Competition**

Participants adhered to strict rules:

- Time Limit: Each speech lasted 5 minutes, with penalties for exceeding the time.
- A warning bell was rung one minute before the end, and a final bell signalled the conclusion.
- Evaluation criteria included clarity of speech, confidence, body language, language proficiency, pronunciation, and voice modulation.
- The speeches were required to be devoid of any offensive, communal, caste-based, or defamatory content.
- Participants delivered their speeches in either English, or Marathi.
- The decision of the judges was final.
